Statistical Dataset Suggestion Form

The FMRC's Graduate Statistical Assistants (http://fmwww.bc.edu/GStat/) are working with Research Services and the Library during Summer 2001, in a project funded by the Associate Vice President for Research, to make statistical datasets more readily accessible on the Boston College network. This may include:

- documenting the dataset and its codebook on a web page, or in a searchable database of datasets;
- placing the dataset on a web server from which it may be downloaded or directly accessed, in the format of one or more statistical packages;
- extracting the data elements so that they may be viewed and retrieved in a webbrowser interface.

Decisions on the appropriate form in which a particular dataset will be made accessible will be made in consultation with primary users of the data, taking into account the technical considerations (e.g. dataset size and complexity) and the human resources necessary to produce that accessibility.
