Access the files with the bcuse command, e.g., bcuse wage1 from within Stata. Hand in a printout from Stata, annotated with your comments.

I recommend you construct (and save) a Stata do-file that performs the analysis; that way you can redo it if necessary without retracing your steps. The "log" icon in the Stata toolbar may be used to create a file containing both your commands and Stata's response. It may be easier to work with a

text-format log; the command 'log using ps2.log' will create a text log. If you save the log, you can access it from your appsstorage.bc.edu directory without connecting to apps.bc.edu or running Stata. Please hand in the log file (not the do-file!)

If you want to annotate your do-file to discuss the results, note that the sequence
