- (c) If $B \subseteq A$, then $A \setminus (A \setminus B) = B$.
- (d) If $A \setminus (A \setminus B) = B$, then $B \subseteq A$.
- (e) $A \cup (B \Delta C) = (A \cup B) \Delta (A \cup C)$.

2. Find a function $f : \mathbf{Z} \rightarrow \mathbf{Z}$ which is

- (a) neither injective nor surjective.
- (b) injective but not surjective.
- (c) surjective but not injective.
